3rd Semester 31.25 points

Up to 8 hours per week on-campus, plus 1 day per week placement in an early childhood setting leading to a 1-week block placement (10 placement days in total across the semester)

4th Semester, 18.75 points

Up to 4 hours per week on-campus, plus 1 day per week placement in an early childhood setting leading to a 1-week block placement (10 placement days in total across the semester)

5th Semester, 37.5 points

Up to 8 hours per week on-campus, plus 2 days per week placement in an early childhood setting leading to a 2-week block placement in early childhood and a 1-week primary school block placement (25 placement days in total across the semester)
