



# Master of Teaching (Early Childhood)

## Course structure, part-time option

### 1ST SEMESTER, 31.25 POINTS

- Up to 8 hours per week on-campus, plus 1 day per week placement in an early childhood setting leading to a 1-week block placement (10 placement days in total across the semester)



### 2ND SEMESTER, 31.25 POINTS

- Up to 8 hours per week on-campus, plus 1 day per week placement in an early childhood setting leading to a 1-week block placement (10 placement days in total across the semester)



### 3RD SEMESTER 31.25 POINTS

- Up to 8 hours per week on-campus, plus 1 day per week placement in an early childhood setting leading to a 1-week block placement (10 placement days in total across the semester)



### 4TH SEMESTER, 18.75 POINTS

- Up to 4 hours per week on-campus, plus 1 day per week placement in an early childhood setting leading to a 1-week block placement (10 placement days in total across the semester)



### 5TH SEMESTER, 37.5 POINTS

- Up to 8 hours per week on-campus, plus 2 days per week placement in an early childhood setting leading to a 2-week block placement in early childhood and a 1-week primary school block placement (25 placement days in total across the semester)
